We are excited to announce The Wall That Heals (TWTH) is coming to Hawai'i for the first time. We believe you have the potential to make a significant impact on this mission.

TWTH is a three-quarter scale replica of the Vietnam Memorial Wall in Washington, D.C. It serves as a powerful tribute to the more than 58,000 men and women who made the ultimate sacrifice during the Vietnam War. This poignant memorial is accompanied by a mobile Education Center, providing a unique opportunity for our community to pay their respects to our local heroes, learn about the Vietnam War, and remember the sacrifices of our veterans. TWTH will be in Hilo, on the Island of Hawai'i, from January 22nd to January 28th, 2024.

Our mission is to make this moving experience accessible to the people of Hawai'i, and the approximate 100,000 veterans who reside in the state, of which 33,000 are Vietnam era. This event will foster unity, healing, and remembrance among our citizens and provide an educational platform for younger generations to understand the significance of this period in our nation's history.

To accomplish this goal, we are seeking financial contributions or in-kind donations from community leaders, such as yourself, who share our commitment to honoring veterans and promoting education.
